Inq. Delaware Indians. See Eubanks at Tohlequah. Red Cloud killed Little Wound's father. His name was Bull Bear, an Ogalalla Chief. Write to Basl about Rosencrantz 4th Cavalry. Sod Agency was started in 1871 says Garnett. Pelo - I say. Yelo means nothing. Garnett says Washictu Ihcheka means not French but any white civilian.

Grattan fight. Many Indians camped there drawing annuities say both Garnett and Hunton. The annuities were goods and rations. Mary Janis froze to death says Garnett. Ditto says Art Bordeaux. Froze to death in a big blizzard going from fort to camp.

Irish - Shagalasha. Ogallalas call Little Missouri Wakpa Chayshuka.

Ogalallas call Grand River Tavahpa Their river driving off Rees.

Che - penis. Cheksa - cut off penis. His real name was Corn Man. Bed in Teton is Oyunke. Jack Russell's name was Nao Pizila. It means

Trousers Dragging The Ground. Pizila by itself means wrinkled.

Garnett translated it as Pants Dragging The Gound but says Wrinkled

Pants would be a better translation. Mitch Bouyer called Kape which means Hammering Out, as in pounded iron by a blacksmith. His father was a blacksmith. Was Emily Janis the sister of Bill Garnett's wife?

Yes. Was he married then? No. Did Emily cut up Yellow Bear.

What is sign talk. Sign talk Napeun Wogalakapi. Heowig father was Red Blanket Makoma. His brother is Fighting Bull Atpiug pirlu Wslu He was a Northern Cheyenne. He was living with Cut Nose at the time but not his son. Roman Nose Wahciui says Black Horse.

Outbreak at Ft. Robinson Black Horse says the Cheyenne who shot the guard was himself shot in the thigh and fell down. He got the soldier's gun and belt and lay there and fired many shots at the soldiers. Says the Cheyennes had 20 or 30 guns hid under the floor of guardhouse that they had smuggled in under their clothing. Some had gun barrels down trouser legs and under blankets.

All men - sitomini. Uncle - lekshi. Frank Appleton from Sioux City
23 or 24 years old. Chief clerk and acting agent at Red Cloud 1873
and 1874 about December was killed by Kicking Bear, one of Crazy
Horse's Indians and later Messiah man. Indian was killed on Platte
and his relatives wanted to kill a white man for revenge. Son of
Running Antelope of Standing Rock warned the agent that the Indians
intended to kill a white man that night. Warning not heeded. Indian
knocked at door and Appleton went out and Indian shot and killed him.
Bullet came through the house and went over my head. The regimental
watchman was asleep and Indian had used a stepladder to get over the
stockade.

Look up Maynadier Treaty with Red Cloud in 1866. Spotted Tail brought in a dead daughter and put her up on a scaffold in the post cemetery. Treaty of 1868. Garnett says Red Cloud was not present at the treaty when the commission was there but came in fall and signed the treaty papers. The commission then had gone to Devils Lake to

make another treaty. When treaty was made Spotted Tail was there.

His camp, however, was on the Republican. Spotted Tail's and Little

Wound's camp was on Republican and they sent up head men to make

the treaty and Red Cloud and his village was up northwest somewhere.

Red Cloud had several wives at different times says Garnett. Yellow
Hand. Black Horse says it was northwest of Ft. Robinson between
Ft. Robinson and Hat Creek on north side of range of bluffs. His brother
Charging Bull lives near Kingfisher, Okla. and was present when
Yellow Hair killed. Yellow Hair was chasing a soldier when he was
killed by the squad of soldiers.

Lake DeSmet called by the Sioux BleWakay - Holy Lake, Mystery Lake.

Policeman - Chanunksa Wha - he carries a club. Geo. Bernard

Chief clerk and acting agent at Sod Agency when John Richard killed.

Red Dog Track - Shunka Oyeluta. Eagle Next - Wambli Hokepi.

War Bonnet - Wapaha Neagapi.

Thunder Bear says N. Platte was called Shell Paukesha. South Platte called Fat river - Washiu Wakpa. Below the forks it was called Scud all way down, this being considered the main stream. Brother is Atkuku. Horse Creek Battle. Thunder Bear says the boy shot by soldiers after the battle was Long Legged Wolf and not a son of Two Face. He was a brother of Brown Bear and a son of Putiy Ishma.

Did any witness ever talk about any of soldiers on ridge being drunk and were any considerable number in that condition. He Dog says some played possum for dead but not drunk. Bear Lying Down says some fired in air and acted as if intoxicated.
